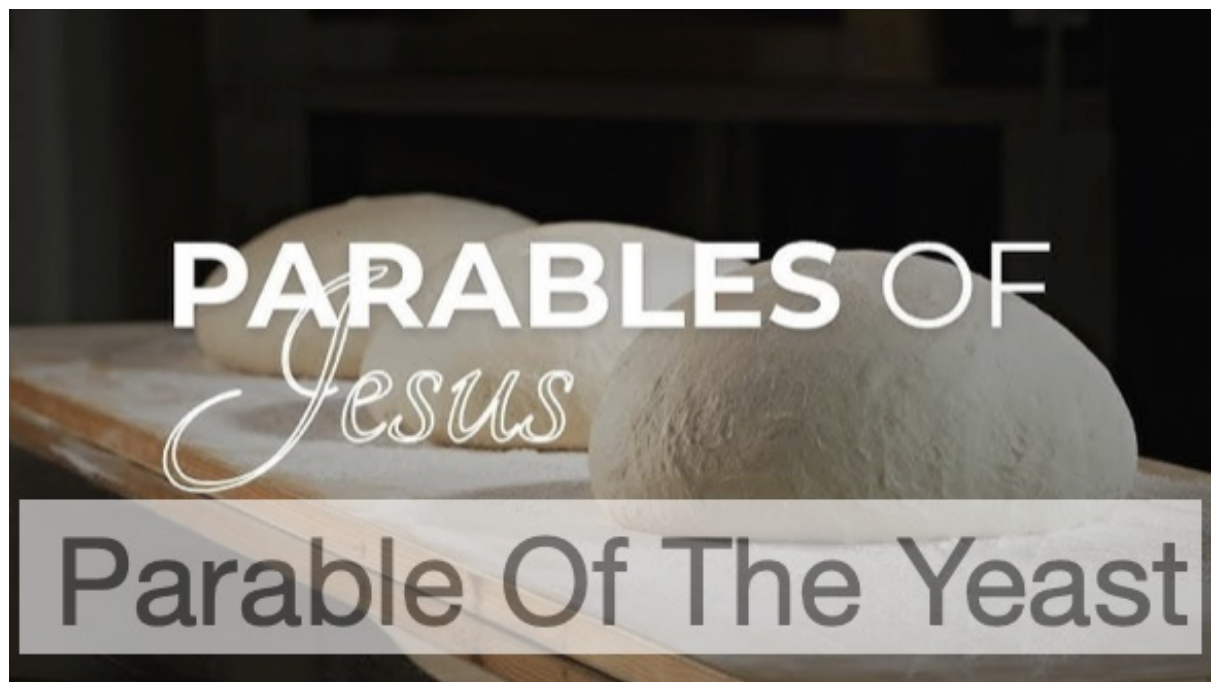

Following The Year(s) Of ^Jesus #198 The Parable Of The Yeast: Let It Rise



The Kingdom of Heaven is like... yeast.

—Matthew 13:33 (NLT)

How Is The Kingdom Like Yeast?

1. It Starts Small But It's Alive.

- *The Kingdom of Heaven is like the yeast a woman used in making bread. Even though she put only a little yeast in three measures of flour, it permeated every part of the dough.*

—Matthew 13:33 (NLT)

- *We will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ.*

—Ephesians 4:15 (NLT)

2. It's Quiet But It Transforms Completely.

- *When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished and they took note that these men had been with Jesus.*

—Acts 4:13 (NIV)

- *Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by*

changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

—Romans 12:2 (NLT)

- *But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.*
—Galatians 5:22-23 (NLT)

3. It Reveals A Hidden God.

- *Jesus always used stories and illustrations like these when speaking to the crowds. In fact, he never spoke to them without using such parables. This fulfilled what God had spoken through the prophet: "I will speak to you in parables. I will explain things hidden since the creation of the world."*
—Matthew 13:34-35 (NLT)
- *And all of us... can be mirrors that brightly reflect the glory of the Lord. And as the Spirit of the Lord works within us, we become more and more like him and reflect his glory even more.*
—2 Corinthians 3:17-18 (NLT)

Follow Through Step:

Spend some time reflecting on your growth. Are you becoming more-and-more like Jesus with each passing year? If not maybe spend some time thinking about the fruit of the Spirit and ask Jesus what you need to work on next.
