

1. Get Ready to read.

 "Your word is a lamp to my feet - a light to my path."

2. When you read The Bible: Start Slow.

- The Good News about Jesus the Messiah, the Son of God,[a] begins with what the prophet Isaiah said would happen. He wrote: "Listen! I will send my messenger ahead of you.He will prepare the way for you."—Mark 1:1-2 ERV
 - This is the family history of Jesus the Messiah. He came from the family of David, who was from the family of Abraham.
