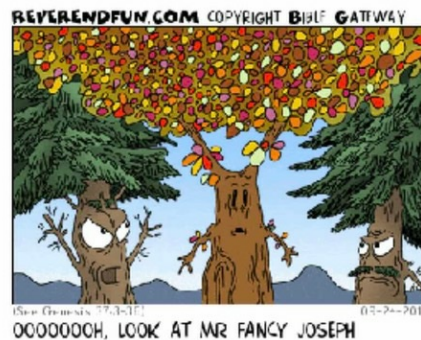


Good Stuff To Know

How Did Jesus Tell The Disciples To Grieve?

1. He Tells Them To Trust In God.

- *Do not let your hearts be troubled. You trust in God; trust also in me.*

—John 14:1 (NLT)

2. Focus On The Future.

- *In my Father's house there are many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.*

—John 14:2-3 (NIV)

3. Don't Worry About Directions.

- *"And you know the way to where I am going."
"No, we don't know, Lord," Thomas said. "We*

have no idea where you are going, so how can we know the way?"
