AMPLIFIED – The Outpouring August 9-10, 2025

Genesis 1:2 (NIV) – "Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters".

John 16:13 (NIV) – "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on His own; He will speak only what He hears, and He will tell you what is yet to come".

"When God began to transform the earth into something beautiful and compatible with His great plan, He started with the work of the Spirit of God. The Holy Spirit begins every work of creation or re-creation" – **David Guzik**

Acts 2:1-4 (AMP) — "When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place, and suddenly a sound came from heaven like a rushing violent wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. There appeared to them tongues resembling fire, which were being distributed [among them], and they rested on each one of them [as each person received the Holy Spirit]. And they were all filled [that is, diffused throughout their being] with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues (different languages), as the Spirit was giving them the ability to speak out [clearly and appropriately]".

Matthew 3:11 (NIV) – "I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me comes One who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire".

"rested" = Greek *kathizo* - "to sit down, settle, or dwell"; idea of "permanence of position or condition"

Leviticus 23:15-17, 21 (NIV) – "From the day after the Sabbath, the day you brought the sheaf of the wave offering, count off seven full weeks. Count off fifty days up to the day after the seventh Sabbath, and then present an offering of new grain to the Lord. From wherever you live, bring two loaves made of two-tenths of an ephah of the finest flour, baked with yeast, as a wave offering of firstfruits to the Lord" – "On that same day you are to proclaim a sacred assembly and do no regular work. This is to be a lasting ordinance for the generations to come, wherever you live".

AMPLIFIED – The Outpouring August 9-10, 2025

Acts 2:5-8 (AMP) — "Now there were Jews living in Jerusalem, devout and Godfearing men from every nation under heaven. And when this sound was heard, a crowd gathered, and they were bewildered because each one was hearing those in the upper room speaking in his own language or dialect. They were completely astonished, saying, 'Look! Are not all of these who are speaking Galileans? Then how is it that each of us hears in our own language or native dialect?'"

Acts 2:12-13 (AMP) — And they were beside themselves with amazement and were greatly perplexed, saying one to another, "What could this mean?" But others were laughing and joking and ridiculing them, saying, "They are full of sweet wine and are drunk!"

Joel 2:28-29, 32a (NIV) — "And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days" — "And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved".

Acts 2:22-24 (AMP) – "Men of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man accredited and pointed out and attested to you by God with [the power to perform] miracles and wonders and signs which God worked through Him in your [very] midst, just as you yourselves know – this man, when handed over [to the Roman authorities] according to the predetermined decision and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross and put to death by the hands of lawless and godless men. But God raised Him up, releasing Him and bringing an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in death's power".

John 10:37-38 (NIV) – "Do not believe me unless I do the works of my Father. But if I do them, even though you do not believe me, believe the works, that you may know and understand that the Father is in me, and I in the Father".

AMPLIFIED – The Outpouring August 9-10, 2025

Acts 2:29-33 (AMP) — "Brothers, I may confidently and freely say to you regarding the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. And so, being a prophet and knowing fully that God had sworn to him with an oath that He would seat one of his descendants on his throne, he foresaw and spoke [prophetically] of the resurrection of the Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed), that He was not abandoned [in death] to Hades (the realm of the dead), nor did His body undergo decay. God raised this Jesus [bodily from the dead], and of that [fact] we are all witnesses. Therefore, having been exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He has poured out this [blessing] which you both see and hear".

Acts 2:36-39 (AMP) – "Therefore, let all the house of Israel recognize beyond all doubt that God has made Him both Lord and Christ (Messiah, Anointed) – this Jesus whom you crucified". Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart [with remorse and anxiety], and they said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brothers, what are we to do?" And Peter said to them, "Repent [change your old way of thinking, turn from your sinful ways, accept and follow Jesus as the Messiah] and be baptized, each of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For the promise [of the Holy Spirit] is for you and your children and for all who are far away [including the Gentiles], as many as the Lord our God calls to Himself".

"Were there not two loaves? Not only shall Israel be saved, but the multitude of the Gentiles shall be turned unto the Lord Jesus Christ" – *Charles Spurgeon*

Zechariah 4:6 (NIV) – So He said to me, "This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: 'Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit', says the Lord Almighty".
