"Brain Rot" is Oxford Word of the Year. Each year the Oxford University Press, the publishing house responsible for producing the Oxford English Dictionary (considered by many to be the defining dictionary of the English language) puts out a word of the year. Jesus said, "For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?" (Matthew 16:26). Our focus must shift from self to Jesus. Only then may we truly find ourselves (Matthew 16:25).
