HOSPITALITY





ECCL. 4:9-12

A NEW COMMAND

John 13:34-35 NIV

In this series, One Another, we'll explore what it truly means to live, serve, and **love** together, woven into the people Jesus intended for us to be. Following Jesus calls us into relationships where **love**, grace, and accountability are shared, helping us grow not just for ourselves but for one another. Together, we can build a culture of **love** and unity, showing God's heart to the world—because we are truly stronger together. Today we will look at the foundation of all the other One Another's in scripture – **LOVE One Another as I have LOVED you!**

John 13:34-35 (NIV) *A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."*

Mark 12:28a-29 (NIV) *Of all the commandments, which is the most important? The most important one, "answered Jesus, "is this: 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these."*

Isaiah 58:3,5b (CSB) “*Why have we fasted, but you have not seen? We have denied ourselves, but you haven’t noticed!*” “*Look, you do as you please on the day of your fast, and oppress all your workers... Will you call this a fast and a day acceptable to the LORD?*”

John 15:12-14, 17 (NIV) “*My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one’s life for one’s friends. You are my friends if you do what I command...This is my command: Love each other.*

1 Corinthians 13:4-8,14 (NLT) *Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged. It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance...Three things will last forever—faith, hope, and love—and the greatest of these is love.*
