ONE ANOTHER

BIBLICAL HOSPITALITY—WE ALL NEED IT!

Hebrews 13:1-2 NIV

Last week in our One Another series, we learned what it means to love as Jesus loves. One way we can do this is by practicing hospitality. While our culture often defines hospitality as entertaining friends or making people comfortable, biblical hospitality goes deeper—it is the love of the stranger. Loving one another means seeing others through Christ's eyes, no matter who they are or where they come from, and creating space where everyone can belong and feel welcome.

Hebrews 13:1-2 (NIV) *“Keep on loving one another as brothers and sisters. Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it.”*

1. God wants everyone united through Jesus

Matthew 25:37-40 (NIV) *“Then the righteous will answer him, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?’*

“The King will reply, ‘Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.’

Romans 12:13 (NIV) “Share with the Lord’s people who are in need. Practice hospitality.”

Ephesians 2:12–13, 19 (NIV) “You are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God’s people and also members of his household.”

2. Hospitality makes us Christlike

Philippians 4:4-7 (NIV) *Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*

1 Peter 4:8-9 (NIV) *Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling.*

3. People need to be connected

Jesus and the Samaritan Woman - John 4:1–42

Jesus Calls the Tax Collector – Matthew 9:9-13

Jesus Visits Zacchaeus – Luke 19:1-10

Jesus Heals a Suffering Woman – Mark 5:25-34

Revelation 3:20 (NIV): “*Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me.*”
