ONE ANOTHER
Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 NLT

Two people are better off than one, for they can help each other succeed. <sup>10</sup> If one person falls, the other can reach out and help. But someone who falls alone is in real trouble. <sup>11</sup> Likewise, two people lying close together can keep each other warm. But how can one be warm alone? <sup>12</sup> A person standing alone can be attacked and defeated, but two can stand back-to-back and conquer. Three are even better, for a triple-braided cord is not easily broken.

We were never meant to follow Jesus alone. In this series, One Another, we'll explore what it truly means to live, serve, and love together, woven into the people Jesus intended for us to be. The Bible reminds us in Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 that we are better able to face life's challenges when we support and encourage *one another*. Following Jesus calls us into relationships where love, grace, and accountability are shared, helping us grow not just for ourselves but for *one another*. Together, we can build a culture of love and unity, showing God's heart to the world—because we are truly stronger together.
