

Psalm 24:3-6, Proverbs 4:20-27 (NIV)

God looks for people of integrity who live holy lives, who are accountable to God and to the Body of Christ. Integrity glorifies God, protects us from stumbling, and encourages growth.

Psalm 24:3-6 (NIV) Who may ascend the mountain of the Lord? Who may stand in his holy place? ⁴ The one who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not trust in an idol or swear by a false god. ⁵ They will receive blessing from the Lord and vindication from God their Savior. ⁶ Such is the generation of those who seek him, who seek your face, God of Jacob.

Proverbs 4:20-27 (NIV) My son, pay attention to my words; listen closely to my sayings. ²¹ Don't lose sight of them; keep them within your heart. ²² For they are life to those who find them, and health to one's whole body. ²³ Guard your heart above all else, for it is the source of life. ²⁴ Don't let your mouth speak dishonestly, and don't let your lips talk deviously. ²⁵ Let your eyes look forward; fix your gaze straight ahead. ²⁶ Carefully consider the path for your feet, and all your ways will be established. ²⁷ Don't turn to the right or to the left; keep your feet away from evil.

What I stand on: A COMMITMENT TO MY PROMISES

What I do: ACTIONS CONSISTENT WITH MY BELIEFS

Matthew 7:21 (NIV) "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of My Father who is in heaven."
