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#### Part 4: Processes and Outcomes

Context: Authentic discipleship means to be like Jesus.

Mandate: \_\_\_\_\_ (Mathew 28:19-20)

Premise: An authentic disciple is formed by an \_\_\_\_\_ process

Process: Disciples commit to an ongoing pattern of:

- Recognizing our \_\_\_\_\_: the extent and gravity of our sin  
(Romans 3:10-18, Romans 6:20-23, Ephesians 2:1-3)
- Realizing our \_\_\_\_\_: change must come from outside ourselves  
(Romans 7:15-25)
- Reflecting on Christ's \_\_\_\_\_: more than intellectual ascent, but a new  
condition (Ephesians 2:4-10, 2 Corinthians 5:14-18)
- Reacting to the Holy Spirit's \_\_\_\_\_: (John 16:7-15)
- Responding Biblically to the \_\_\_\_\_: repentance, growth and  
change are normalized (2 Peter 1:3-15)

This process takes place best in the context of the body of Christ. The Church seeks:
