IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

What should we do when we are in shock or confused? Go to God's word and obey His commands and instructions to us. We can trust God and obey Him, because He is good. Joseph obeyed God's instructions. Matthew 1:18-25, Joseph Accepts Jesus as His Son



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid who in their life has been a good example of someone who obeys God. Ask your kid when the last time was they read God's word. Encourage them to spend time in it today.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

What difficult place did Joseph find himself in?

What reason do we have to be able to trust God and obey Him?

How can you hear God's word?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"But the angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid. I bring you good news. It will bring great joy for all the people.'" Luke 2:10



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Trusting God and obeying Him takes practice. One way to help your child see the benefit of obeying God is by talking about past mistakes and the consequences that happen from not obeying God. You can use stories in the Bible as an example. Then you can use stories in the Bible where people obeyed God and there was a good outcome. We can obey God because He is a good God and knows what is best for us.
