5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

Who is worthy of our worship? Jesus! We can worship Jesus by focusing our attention on Him, by praising Him for what He has done, and by committing our lives to following Him. The wise men worshiped Jesus with many gifts. Matthew 2:1-12, The Wise Men Visit Jesus



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid what it means to worship God.

Ask your kid what spiritual gifts they can give back to Jesus by using them for His glory.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

Why do you think it was worth it to the wise men to cross the desert to see Jesus?

What was the promise that Jesus would bring?

What promise do we have to look forward to in the future? Why do we need Jesus for this promise to happen?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"But the angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid. I bring you good news. It will bring great joy for all the people.'" Luke 2:10



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Jesus is the promise that God gave us for salvation and eternal life. There is nothing more important than this promise. We can share this with our children and invite them to partake in the best gift that anyone could ever receive, eternal life in heaven. If your child has not accepted Jesus into their heart yet, invite them to pray the prayer today. You can pray like this, "Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus to save me from my sins. Please forgive me for my sins. I give my life to you and I pray for you to fill me with your Holy Spirit and help me to live each day walking with You! Thank you that one day I will be in heaven because you have defeated sin and death on the cross. In Jesus' name, Amen!"
