Over the last year Bill has poured his passion for Christ into his primary disciple Chris Mahon with excellent results, training him in his faith and as FGR house manager. Chris has become an enthusiastic advocate for Jesus and discipleship.

Several church, organization and



local government leaders are now more aware of all that FGR offers and have committed to sending student referrals our way. These include Chain Breaker Ministries in Columbus, the Brown County Recovery and Wellness Coalition, Brown County and Morgan County Corrections, other recovery-focused facilities and local pastors.

"Our open house event in July resulted in student referrals, and some are still possibilities," said Bill. "Most recently, we are developing more compelling outreach materials and a simplified application with the goal of finding more men who can benefit from FGR's teaching. Most importantly, we know that God will send the men He wants for FGR in His perfect timing."


