"Defund Planned Parenthood"

President Trump's "One Big Beautiful" bill prohibits clinics and providers that offer abortions from accepting federal Medicaid funding for any services for 1 year. This was a reduction from the 10 year he proposed. These are the clinics that have already closed. Keep praying!

- ◆ Planned Parenthood closed its flagship SoHo location in New York City.
- ◆ Planned Parenthood of Michigan announced a 10% cut in staffing and closed 4 clinics.
- ◆ 4 clinics in Illinois closed by the end of March
- ◆ 1 Clinic in California closes.
- ◆ 2 clinics in Utah closed and clinical and education staff in others decreased.
- ◆ 1 clinic in Vermont closed in June.
