Read John 14:12-18

1. Jesus said that those who believe in Him would go on to do greater works. What examples in scripture do we have of the disciples fulfilling this prophecy? (Acts 2 is one example)

Read John 16:7-18

2. The disciples didn't understand what Jesus meant. Can you share about a time when you couldn't understand what God was doing in your life, but later His good purpose was revealed to you?

3. In John 14:13 Jesus said that whatever believers ask in His name, that He will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. What does it mean to ask in His name?

4. God is not a personal genie - but God is inviting us into something joyful and powerful. Read John 16:23-24. Can you share about a time where you have asked in Jesus' name and received, resulting in joy?

5. Obedience is a critical part of aligning with the Father and being a part of His work. Mark 14:38 says, 'Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.' When you feel the weakness of your flesh, what is a good way to ensure that you will stay obedient? What is it that motivates us to be obedient?

6. Walking in the Spirit, being supported by the Spirit we can accomplish God's work for us. What are some evidences of walking in the Spirit? (Galatians 5:16-26)

7. What are some practical ways that you can stay faithful in prayer, obedience, and walk in the Spirit?
