"...if our gospel narratives about the coming of Jesus tell us anything, it's that waiting when God seems to be silent is a crucial aspect of our shared calling as followers of Jesus. Simeon and Anna, like many in Israel over the years, had been waiting for God's redemption to come and now saw it being fulfilled in the child Jesus. Mary saw all that was unfolding around her and rested, pondering it all in her heart." I (Micah) read this quote in a letter from a dear friend recently and it really hit me as we have found ourselves in a very slow season of waiting, one which we honestly don't want to linger in much longer. We are still working to expand our team of ministry partners and raise more support so that we can re-engage in ministry full-time. We have had some sweet moments of encouragement where we have seen the Lord provide from places we did not expect but we have had a lot of moments of discouragement as we feel disconnected and impatient. As we are still grieving our life overseas and navigate the waters of transition, it has been easy to question everything. The quote above was a reminder that the waiting is such an important part of our walk with the Lord. I've seen the Lord use times of waiting in the past to sanctify me and remind me that everything we are doing isn't about me anyways – it always has been and always will be about serving and loving God. I trust that as the Lord provides and leads us He will continue to show us what He is doing within our hearts as we prepare for a new and very different season of ministry than we have done before. As we enter the New Year, may you be filled with an unexplainable and unending joy in the Lord that surpasses any circumstance you may find yourself in. Praise! Our support deficit is less than it was before! Ezra has finally figured out how to nap well independently. Prayer requests: For boldness for Micah during the weekly library story times to interact more with other moms. For Zac to find some community and friends in our area that he can do life with. To trust the Lord to continue to provide for our increased support needs.
