Believe God



<u>Scripture:</u> *Mark 9:23* "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."



<u>Reflection:</u> Consider a specific area in your life where you need to trust God more and take a step of faith.



<u>Prayer:</u> Lord, bolster my faith in areas of doubt and help me to trust You completely.

Be Humble



<u>Scripture:</u> **1 Peter 5:5** "All of you, clothe yourselves with humility towards one another."



<u>Reflection:</u> Practise humility by actively listening to others' viewpoints and valuing their contributions.



<u>Prayer:</u> Lord, help me to listen more than I speak and to value others above myself.





Be A Giver



<u>Scripture:</u> *Acts 20:35* "It is more blessed to give than to receive."



<u>Reflection:</u> Look for a way to give back to your community today, whether through volunteering, donating, or helping a neighbour.



<u>Prayer:</u> Generous Father, show me how I can be a blessing to others in my community today.

Judge Yourself



<u>Scripture:</u> **1** *Corinthians* **11:31** "For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged."



<u>Reflection:</u> Examine your motives and attitudes, asking God to reveal any hidden pride or selfishness.



<u>Prayer:</u> Heavenly Father, help me to be honest in my selfexamination and to align my heart with Your will.
