Scripture: Luke 6:36 "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful."



<u>Reflection:</u> Reflect on how being merciful can create a more forgiving and understanding environment at home or work.

Fear The Lord



<u>Scripture:</u> *Isaiah 8:13* "The LORD of hosts, Him you shall hallow; let Him be your fear."



<u>Reflection:</u> How does fearing the Lord help you in making ethical decisions, especially when no one else is watching?



<u>Prayer:</u> Lord, instill in me a fear of You that guides my ethical choices, especially in private moments.

Believe God



<u>Scripture:</u> *Mark 9:23* "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."



<u>Reflection:</u> Think about a difficult situation where believing in God's power can bring hope and change.



<u>Prayer:</u> Faithful God, in difficult situations, let my belief in You be the source of hope and strength.

Be Humble



<u>Scripture:</u> **1** *Peter 5:5* "All of you, clothe yourselves with humility towards one another."



<u>Reflection:</u> Humility also involves being teachable. <u>Embrace learning from others today, regardless of their status.</u>



<u>Prayer:</u> Lord, grant me a teachable spirit to learn from others, reflecting humility in my heart.



Be A Giver



<u>Scripture:</u> *Acts 20:35* "It is more blessed to give than to receive."



<u>Reflection:</u> Consider how you can give your time in a meaningful way, such as volunteering for a cause you believe in.



<u>Prayer:</u> Generous Father, show me where I can donate my time for the greater good and find joy in the act of serving.

Judge Yourself



<u>Scripture:</u> **1** *Corinthians* **11:31** "For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged."



Reflection: Examine your recent conversations. Have they been uplifting and edifying, or do they need improvement?



<u>Prayer:</u> Lord, help me to reflect on my words and conversations, guiding me to speak in ways that honour You.
