Be Merciful



Scripture: *Luke 6:36* "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful."



Reflection: Reflect on how being merciful can create a more forgiving and understanding environment at home or work.



Prayer: Heavenly Father, allow me to create an atmosphere of mercy and understanding in my surroundings.

Fear The Lord



Scripture: *Isaiah 8:13* "The LORD of hosts, Him you shall hallow; let Him be your fear."



Reflection: How does fearing the Lord help you in making ethical decisions, especially when no one else is watching?



Prayer: Lord, instill in me a fear of You that guides my ethical choices, especially in private moments.

Believe God



Scripture: **Mark 9:23** "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."



Reflection: Think about a difficult situation where believing in God's power can bring hope and change.



Prayer: Faithful God, in difficult situations, let my belief in You be the source of hope and strength.

Be Humble



Scripture: **1 Peter 5:5** "All of you, clothe yourselves with humility towards one another."



Reflection: Humility also involves being teachable. Embrace learning from others today, regardless of their status.



Prayer: Lord, grant me a teachable spirit to learn from others, reflecting humility in my heart.

Be A Giver



Scripture: *Acts 20:35* "It is more blessed to give than to receive."



Reflection: Consider how you can give your time in a meaningful way, such as volunteering for a cause you believe in.



Prayer: Generous Father, show me where I can donate my time for the greater good and find joy in the act of serving.

Judge Yourself



Scripture: *1 Corinthians 11:31* "For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged."



Reflection: Examine your recent conversations. Have they been uplifting and edifying, or do they need improvement?



Prayer: Lord, help me to reflect on my words and conversations, guiding me to speak in ways that honour You.
