

COMMUNITY CAMP VISITOR POLICY

General Policy

The safety, focus, and spiritual growth of our students are our top priorities during camp. To maintain a secure and distraction-free environment, <u>visitors</u> will not be permitted at camp, unless otherwise approved in advance for a specific purpose.

Community Camp is a closed event. Only registered students, approved leaders, and authorized staff are permitted on Camp Cotubic grounds during the week of camp.

Visitor Exceptions

<u>Exception #1:</u> The **only** approved visitor event during Community Camp is our Baptism & Testimony Night (Thursday, July 16). Families and invited guests are encouraged to attend this evening as we support and celebrate our students who are declaring their faith publicly.

- All visitors must check in upon arrival at the Community Camp Office.
- Visitors will receive a bracelet that must be worn at all times while present on campgrounds.
- Visitors must remain in approved, public areas for the duration of the event.
- Any visitor not adhering to check-in procedures or safety guidelines may be asked to leave.

<u>Exception #2:</u> If a unique situation arises that requires a parent or guardian to visit camp (such as a medical or family need), arrangements must be made **in advance** with your Campus Next Gen Coordinator. Unscheduled visits will not be permitted.

Purpose of This Policy

By limiting visitors, we create the space for students to disconnect from distractions and more fully connect with Jesus and those around them. Through the Baptism & Testimony Night, we ensure that families can still celebrate significant spiritual moments while maintaining the integrity and safety of the camp experience.
