Lighting Standards for Services

Lighting plays a vital role in creating a space for people to encounter Jesus without distraction. The purpose of these lighting standards is to set clear expectations and maintain consistency across all campuses. Each look is pre-programmed to ensure smooth transitions and professional execution.

1. Lighting Goals

- Clarity: Ensure everyone on stage is clearly visible without unnecessary shadows or distractions.
- **Atmosphere**: Support the tone of the service—engaging during worship, focused during speaking, and focused during videos.
- **Excellence**: Provide high-quality, consistent lighting that reflects our worship culture. Excellence is how we operate, creating an environment where people can focus on Jesus without distraction.

Note: Foot candles (fc) are a measurement of light intensity.

2. Service Lighting Looks

Pre-Service Look

- Purpose: Set a welcoming atmosphere as people enter.
- Details:
 - Stage lights OFF.
 - Ambient house lighting at 50-70% to encourage conversations and movement.
 - Foot Candle Target: 20-50 fc for the house lighting.

Worship Look

- Purpose: Create an engaging atmosphere while directing focus on worship.
- Details:
 - Full stage light.
 - House lights at 20-35% to keep focus on the stage while allowing the congregation to see one another.
 - Foot Candle Target: 60-80 fc on stage performers.
 - Foot Candle Target: **2-5 fc** for the house lighting.

Speaking Look

- **Purpose**: Ensure clear visibility and focus on the speaker with minimal distraction.
- Details:
 - Stage lights: Consistent lighting focused on the speaker's position.
 - o House lights at 50-70%.
 - Foot Candle Target: 60-80 fc on the speaker.
 - Foot Candle Target: 20-50 fc for the house lighting.

Video Look

- Purpose: Create an engaging atmosphere while directing focus on videos.
- Details:
 - Stage lights OFF.
 - House lights at **35-50%** to keep focus on the screens.
 - Foot Candle Target: 5-20 fc for the house lighting.
