



LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 1-18-26

CONNECT

Pastor Doug said that your reputation is what you leave behind when you're gone. With that said, what three words describe how you would like people to think of you and why?

GROW

- What stood out to you the most this week from the service, text, or message and why?
- Paul tells us that the Thessalonians received the Gospel in much affliction. What hardships or conflicts have you experienced because of your faith in Christ? How can you redeem those hardships for the sake of the Gospel?
- The essence of Christian discipleship is "follow me as I follow Christ (1 Cor.11)." Who played the largest role in your discipleship when you were a new Christian and who are you passing that onto right now?
- Paul encourages the Thessalonians to wait for the Lord's return. How can waiting be an active activity especially for the Christian? What should we be doing while we're waiting and why?

What is one practical thing you can do this week to help someone else take a step forward in their relationship with Christ? How can your Life Group help you with this?
