IT TAKES A CHURCH

ROMANS 16:1-16

People matter. Full stop. They matter more than your reputation, your stuff, your 401K, or your leisure time. Everything in this world is perishable and fleeting. Only people, made in the image of God, are eternal.

In this week's text the apostle Paul is going to take the time to recognize 29 individuals by name or association along with 4 other groups of unnamed congregations or house churches. Some of them were male and some were female. Some were Jewish converts, and some were Gentile converts and yet they were one in the Body of Christ.

There is much we can learn, as a local church, from their example of love, partnership, honor and unity.

CONNECT

Romans 16 is an example of the fact that people matter. With that said, who is someone from your childhood who made a significant impact on your life and how did they affect you?

GROW

- What part of this week's service, text, or message stood out the most to you and why?

- How would you explain the difference between attending a local church and being a part of a local church? What would you say to someone who said they had "given up" on local church attendance?
- Paul recognizes both men and women along with Jewish and Gentile Christians in our text. How can diversity be a strength in a local church. How can a body of believers maintain unity in their diversity?
