LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 12-21-25

CONNECT

Attending the Candlelight Service has become a tradition for many of our families. What Christmas traditions did you have growing up and what traditions, if any, do you observe now?

GROW

- What part of this week's service, text, or message stood out to you the most and why?
- Paul, in Philippians 2:1-4, is seeking to promote unity within the church community. What do you do or not do for the sake of unity within the church or your own family?
