
BREESPORT BAPTIST CHURCH

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 3-31-24

CONNECT

In this week's text the apostle Paul makes a point to emphasize the fact that the resurrection of Jesus was authenticated by a great many eyewitnesses. Have you ever been an eyewitness to something that you had to later give an account of? If so, what was that?

GROW

- What about this week's service, text, or message impacted you the most and why?
- It is evident that the Gospel was central to Paul's teaching. Why is the Gospel central to marriage, parenting, work, friendships, money, and every other part of life?
- What do you make of the fact that the apostles (except for John) all suffered terrible deaths, Paul – an enemy of Christ, became His greatest ambassador, and even Jesus's own brother James died for Him because they were all eyewitnesses to the resurrection?
- In your words, how would you explain the fact that Christianity rises and falls on the historical reality of the resurrection of Christ? How is the glory of God seen in the resurrection of Jesus from the dead?

What is one practical thing you can do this week to live in light of the resurrection and it's transforming effect on your life? How can your Life Group help you with this?




LAFF is starting back up on April 12th!
