MARK 2:23-28

All the while we treat work-life balance like it's some kind of mythical unicorn - something to be imagined but, ultimately, never achieved.

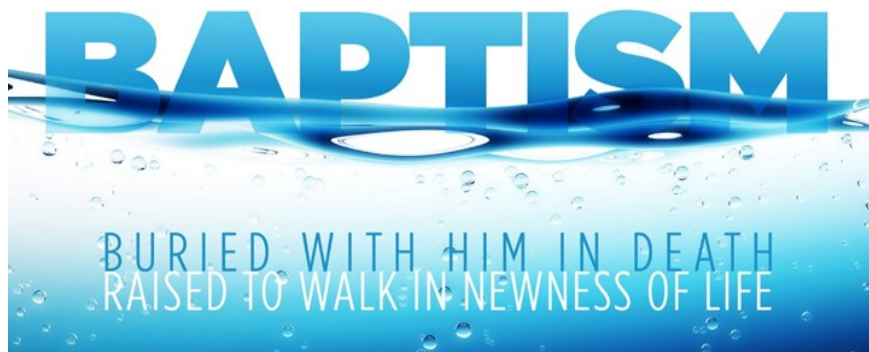
