The apostle Paul speaks of acting like a nursing mother to the Thessalonian believers. With that said, what noble characteristic did you see in your mother and how has that shaped how you live your life today?

GROW

- What stood out to you the most this week from the service, text, or message and why?
- What characteristics do you personally look for in a leader that you would be confident to follow and why? What red flags do you look for in a leader, and which would cause you to leave a church or other organization?
- Everyone wants to be liked, but what is the danger of “seeking glory from people (verse 6)?” How does understanding who you are in Christ safeguard the heart of the Christian from this temptation?
- Paul speaks of being entrusted with the Gospel in verse 4. How are you stewarding the Gospel that has been committed to you and what else has God entrusted to you to steward well for His glory? How can good or poor stewardship impact your efforts to evangelize non-Christians?
