# <u>Maundy Thursday</u> <u>Seder Service</u>

On March 28th, in the week preceding Easter Sunday, GPBC will

have a Maundy Thursday service. The service will be a Christian Seder Service and Potluck Meal in the Fellowship Hall.

So that we can properly prepare for the correct number of people, you should sign up in the Communication Center of the Narthex. Please sign up for a main dish, vegetable/side, or dessert. If you feel adventurous and would like to prepare and bring a traditional Passover dish, please see Debra Wood. Children are welcome to attend as the Passover Meal was traditionally a family event but note that sampling of symbolic foods will be included in the service.

To fully understand how we came to be Christians, we are encouraged to understand our roots in Judaism. This service will allow us to experience and learn about the ceremony that started with Israel's liberation from slavery and ultimately became a blessing for the world through salvation from sin. As Christians, we have the added assurance that our Messiah has come. Come experience this wonderful event.
