Quarterly Business Meeting Decisions

Follow-up Report from 2nd Quarter Business Meeting

OLD BUSINESS:– No Old Business discussed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Under Article IV. Standing Committees in the church Bylaws, the Wedding Host/Hostess Committee was changed from a sub-committee of Building & Grounds to its own status as a standalone committee.

The \$3,015.00 reimbursement received from Church Mutual in response to our claim of \$4,015.00 in vandalism damage to the church HVAC system was approved to be applied to line item 500-4i. This line item is where payment for the damage came from and effectively reimburses all but the \$1,000.00 deductible for the claim.

The request to transfer \$1,000.00 from line item 500-7b Office Duplicating Equipment to line item 500-3d Maintenance Supplies to support supplies used by Building & Grounds Committee members for work activities at the church rather than paid to outside professionals was approved.

The proposal to reassign three (3) spaces in the church facility was tabled temporarily and a Special Project Committee made up of the Pastor and 4 individuals including a Trustee, Deacon, member of the choir, and an At-Large church member selected. This committee will discuss alternatives in reassigning spaces and present their proposal to the church for approval in a Special Called Business Meeting by the end of August 2023.
