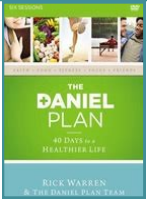

Special Business Meeting

Follow-up from August 2, 2023
2nd Quarter Business Meeting

Wednesday, August 23, 2023 will be a special called business meeting to discuss the proposal of the Special Project Committee.

The Committee examined the temporarily tabled proposal (referenced below) of reassigning three spaces in the church facility and will present their proposal at the August 23, 2023 meeting.

Tabled Proposal from August 2, 2023:

The proposal to reassign three (3) spaces in the church facility was tabled temporarily and a Special Project Committee made up of the Pastor and 4 individuals including a Trustee, Deacon, member of the choir, and an At-Large church member selected. This committee will discuss alternatives in reassigning spaces and present their proposal to the church for approval in a Special Called Business Meeting by the end of August 2023.
