The Danger of Doing Without Dwelling

In our busy Christian lives, it is easy to confuse activity with intimacy. We can serve, sing, teach, give, and even lead and yet quietly drift from the presence of the very One we are serving. This is not a new problem. When Martha busied herself with preparations, while Mary simply sat at Jesus' feet, our Lord said: "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled about many things, but one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the better portion, which will not be taken away from her" (Luke 10:41–42).

The danger is subtle: we can perform for Christ while neglecting to be with Christ. Our hands may be full of service, but our hearts empty of His Spirit. Jesus Himself warned that on the last day some will say, "Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name... and do many mighty works in your name?"—and yet He will reply, "I never knew you" (Matthew 7:22–23). The issue is not the absence of works, but the absence of relationship.

This is why our vision as a church begins with being **rooted in Christ**. Only when our roots sink deep into His presence can our service bear fruit that lasts. Apart from Him, we can do nothing (John 15:5). In Him, even the smallest act of faithfulness becomes an eternal seed.

Let us not trade the "better portion" for busyness. Before we rush to perform, may we first pause to dwell. May our lives and ministries be marked not just by what we do for God, but by the joy of being with God.
