Disciple or Church Member


The terms “disciple of Jesus” and “church member” are often used interchangeably. However, they represent two distinct concepts with different implications for faith, commitment, and lifestyle. Understanding these differences is crucial for anyone seeking a Biblical relationship with Jesus Christ.

Disciple of Jesus: A disciple is someone who actively follows Jesus, striving to learn from His teachings and to apply them to everyday life. Discipleship is rooted in personal transformation, surrender, and growth. Jesus called His disciples to “*deny themselves, take up their cross, and follow Him*” (Matthew 16:24). This implies a life of devotion, sacrifice, and obedience. Being a disciple involves daily commitment to spiritual disciplines such as prayer, reading scripture, serving others, and sharing the gospel.

Church Member: A church member is someone who formally belongs to a local church congregation. Members typically attend services, participate in church activities, and may have voting rights in church affairs. Church membership provides a sense of belonging, fellowship, and support, but does not automatically equate to being a disciple. While some church members are committed disciples, others may attend for social, cultural, or familial reasons without engaging deeply in the teachings of Jesus.

While the service of church members is important for the functioning of the local church, being a church member does not necessarily indicate a personal, transformative relationship with Jesus. The Bible never explicitly mentions being a church member, but it does talk about being part of the body of Christ. The church is described as a single body with many parts (members), each with a role, emphasizing interdependence (1 Cor 12:12-27). Because we are interdependent, being part of the body of Christ means each of us are accountable to Him. In fact, Jesus taught about church discipline (Matthew 18), which requires members to be accountable to each other to address sin within the body.

Deacon's Devotional

Some Prayer Guidelines

Prayer is communication with God. Talking with Almighty God is the greatest privilege that we have.

God desires a growing relationship with you. Communication is essential for a relationship to develop. Involve God in every part of your life: every decision and every action. In that sense you should pray without ceasing -- always being in communication with God.

However, we need special prayer times focused completely on the Lord. He is worthy of our time and attention -- and we require this time with Him to develop spiritually.

Remember the instruction given in Psalm 100:4, "Enter His gates with thanksgiving, and His courts with praise; give thanks to Him and praise His name." If you seem to run out of words to praise God, use some of the examples found in the book of Psalms.

Many use the model prayer, we call it the Lord's Prayer, that our Lord gave us in Matthew 6:9-13 as a guideline for their special daily prayer time. Some of the principles taught are:

First, you are praying to your Father. Second, worship and honor God. Third, pray that God's will be done before praying about your own or others' needs. Fourth, ask for God's forgiveness and help. And last, finish by praising God.

During times of prayer many find it helpful as a memory aid to have a prayer list of people and things to pray for. Also, keeping a journal of your prayer requests and answers is beneficial and will bless you tremendously as the years go by. God has answered so many of my prayer requests, I've lost count.

Always base your prayer on Scripture. Scripture is God's answer. Receiving from God in prayer involves taking His answer (His Word) to Him and receiving your request by faith.

Does God answer every prayer request? Yes, I feel he does. We never get everything we pray for because He, in his infinite wisdom, knows what is good for us and what is not. And also, we as mere mortals cannot comprehend or fathom God's master plan for us.
