Years of Silence

The promise that God would send a Savior (Messiah) occurs throughout the Old Testament until about 400 B.C. when the prophet Malachi's voice fell silent.

Silence for 400 years! Where was God? Had He given up on us and abandoned us to our sin. We had disobeyed Him and rebelled against Him. We had turned to other gods, giving them our worship instead of

YHWH, the one true God. Had God said enough or was He still at work in preparing the world for His plan of redemption?

Silence from God, 400-0 B.C.? While this was a time of no new scripture, many significant events occurred, including the translation of the Old Testament into the common language of Greek (the Septuagint), development of new religious and social structures like synagogues. The political and social changes led to the emergence of different religious and political groups, such as the Sadducees and the Pharisees. Just because we don't hear God, it doesn't mean He is silent. Today, we can see that during this 400-year period God was preparing the world for the arrival of Jesus. Instead of silence, God was working "behind the scenes" to set the stage for His coming.

Then God spoke! "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord." ... Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying, "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests." Luke 2:10-14

Don't be discouraged this Christmas when it appears God is not active (silent). Maybe you are discouraged by relationships, by the direction of the world's culture, or even by the church's lack of faith. We have the certain Hope that God loves us and is not silent. Be confident, God's plan of redemption and restoration is happening right now. His kingdom on earth began with the birth of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and He will give you everything you need. Luke 12:31

"8 And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. 9 An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. 10 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. 11Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. 12 This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger." 13 Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying, 14 "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests." 15 When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about." 16 So they hurried off and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in the manger. 17 When they had seen him, they spread the word concerning what had been told them about this child." Luke 2:8-17

It makes me smile when I remember the fun I had playing Hide and Seek as a child, and more so as I have played it as a parent and grandparent. The game originated in ancient Greece by Julius Pollux in the 2nd century AD, and was originally called *Apodidraskinda*. It was played then in a similar way to how it is played today. While this is a fun game to play with children, it's not so with God.

When it comes to our relationship with God, when we want to hide from God's plan for us and we seek joy from worldly relationships, we are doomed for a disappointing and lonely life. What do you think will happen when we attend a church service only to seek our friends, only wanting to hear good things, not desiring to hear what God is trying to tell us? Do you think we can hide from God? That He doesn't know where we are and what we are doing and saying?

Instead of playing games with our spiritual relationship, let's respond like the shepherds did thousands of years ago as in Luke 2. Let us leave the world behind as we run seeking God and then we share the good news of Jesus with others. We cannot have Christmas without Christ.

1840—Born into a wealthy southern USA family

1858—Became a Christian after a trip to the Holy Land

1861—One of the first American women to earn a college degree in Master of Arts

1862-1865—Teacher and nurse during the Civil War

1873—Sailed September 1st to China as a missionary, to teach, plant churches and care for women and children—winning many over with her shortbread cookies,

1888—Challenged WMU to financially support international missionaries. This became our annual Christmas offering.

1912— Starved to death with her Chinese people weighing only 50 lbs. (Fellow missionaries were taking Lottie to America at that time)

Cottie Moon was only 4 feet 3 inches tall—BUT WHAT A GLORY TO GOD!!
