

Sound Loop at Trinity

If you have trouble hearing in church check out the Hearing Loop. The loop covers all the pews on the main floor in the church proper. There are two ways to use the loop. **1)** If your hearing-aids have a "T-coil" in them, you turn on the coil and your hearing-aids will lock onto the PA system signal. You may have to see your hearing-aid specialist to see if you have "T-coils" and learn how to turn them on. **2)** If your hearing-aids do not have a T-coil, or you do not have hearing aids, we have receivers with headphones (in the narthex) Just pick one up before the service, put on the head-phones, turn the top knob "on" and adjust the volume. You are also welcome to use your own head-phones. Just unplug the churches and plug yours in. (Standard 1/8" stereo plug.) God's blessing as you listen to His Word.




