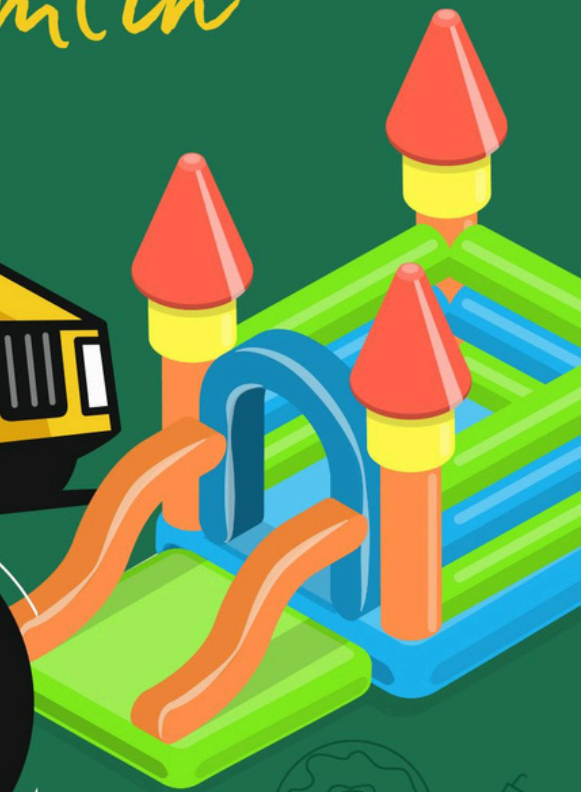

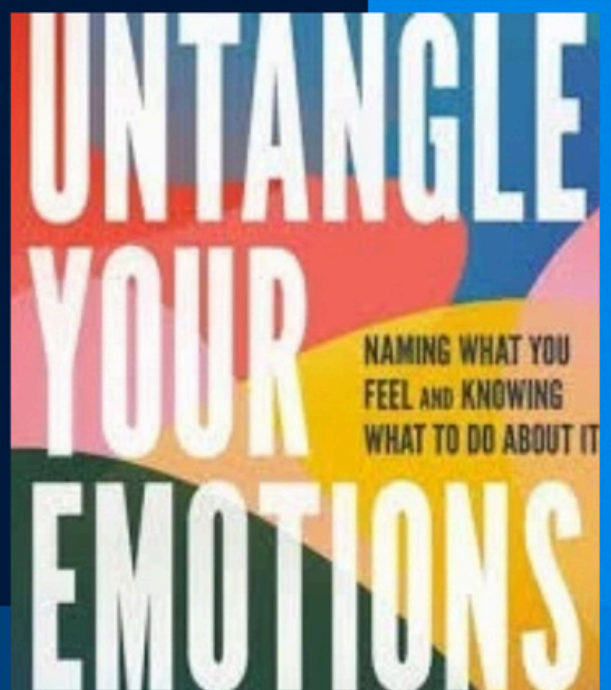

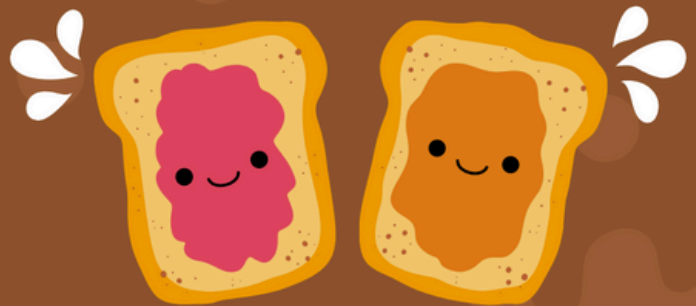

TUTORING SANTIAGO:

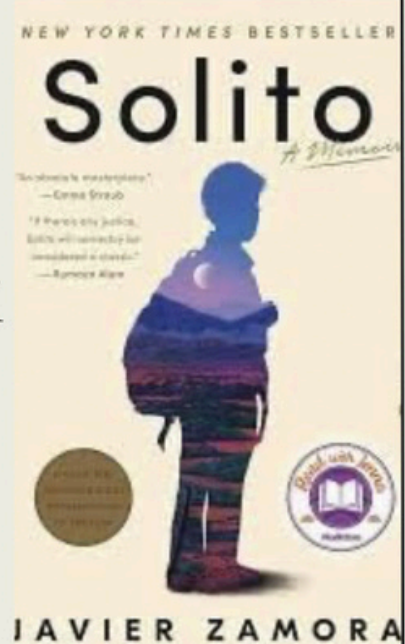
