

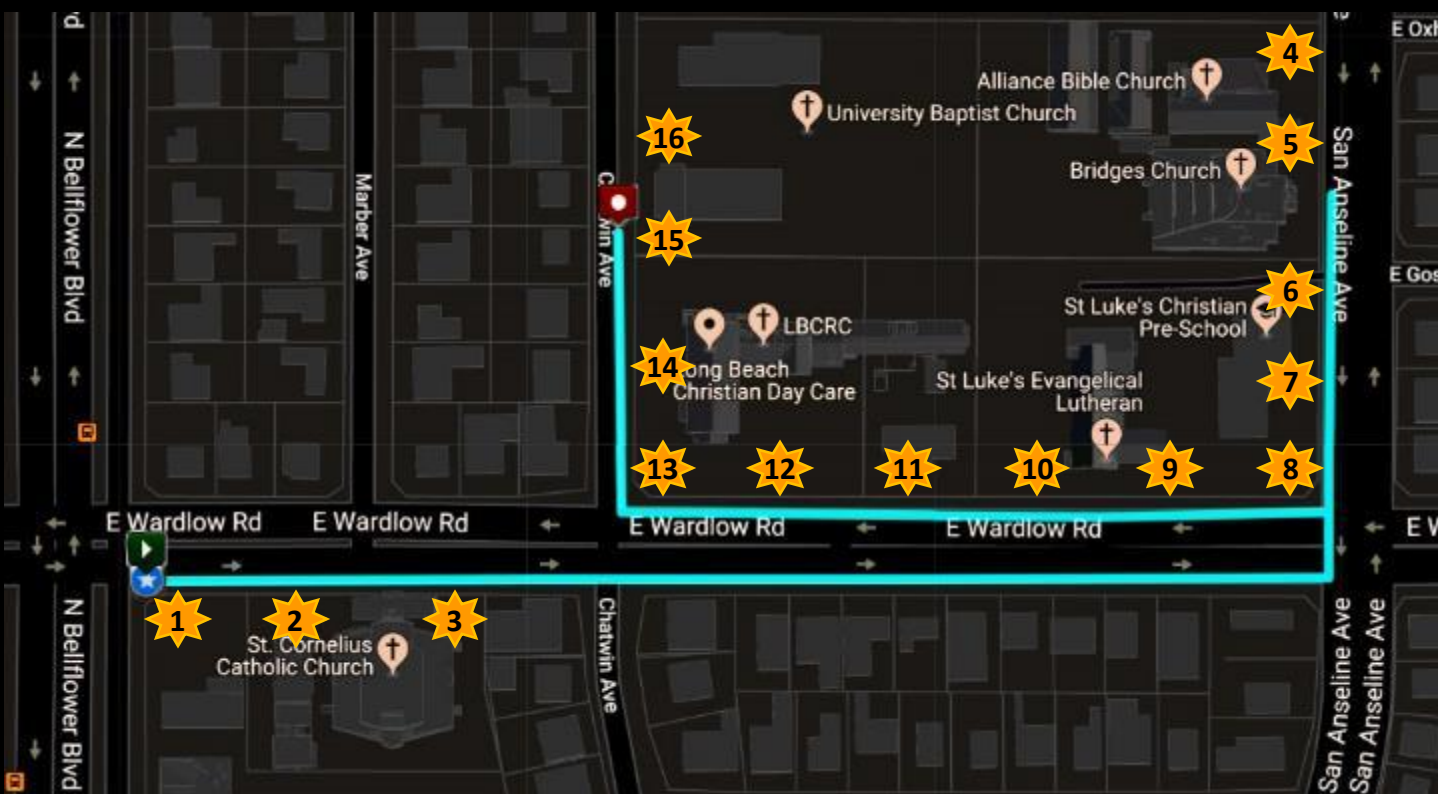
Portraits of the Prince of Peace

generation.”

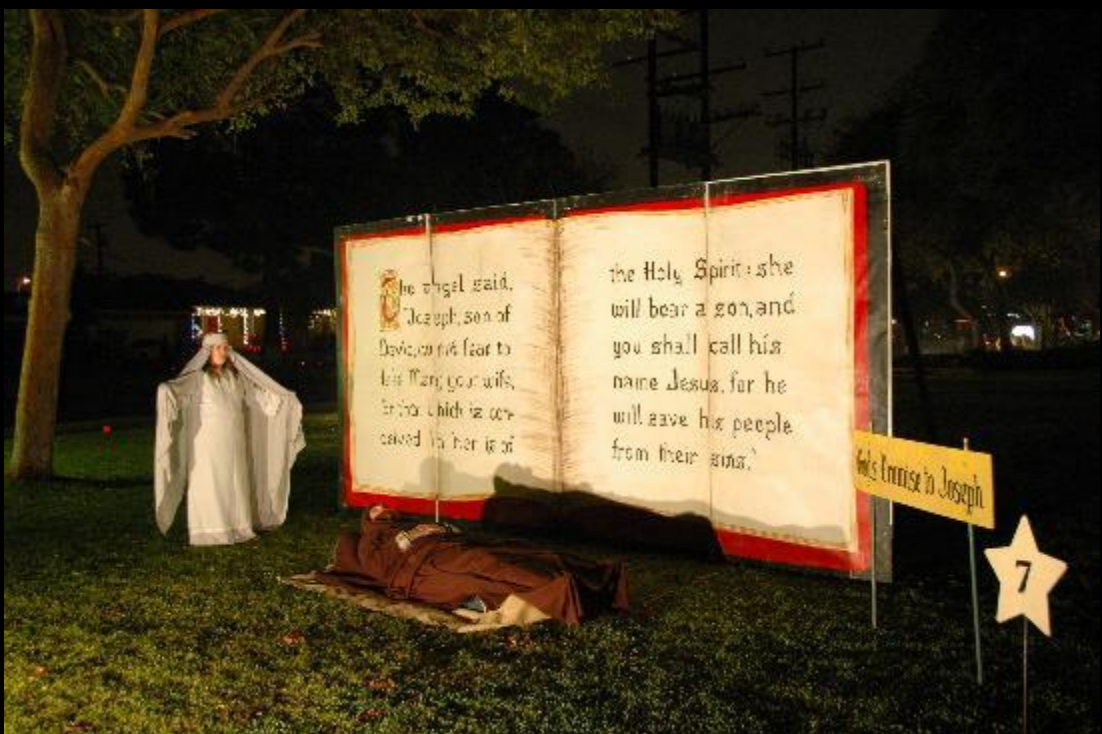
