3 Creation, Week, Sabbath, History: 7

- According to the Dead Sea Scrolls, human history was believed to be structured into a 7,000-year timeline, divided into four epochs, with the first three ages lasting 2,000 years each, followed by a 1,000-year Sabbath period. This was a divine blueprint derived from the seven days of creation. The 7,000-Year TimelineThe Essenes, the community associated with the Dead Sea Scrolls, believed in a divine plan for history that mirrored the creation narrative. They divided this timeline into four distinct ages:
- The Age of Chaos (2,000 years): From Adam to Abraham.
- The Age of Torah (2,000 years): From Abraham to Jesus (Messiah), a time when God established his laws and covenant.
- The Age of Grace (2,000 years): From the birth of Jesus to his second coming, an era of salvation through the Forgiveness of Sin.
- The Age of the Kingdom (1,000 years): The final 1,000-year period of peace and righteousness under Christ's rule.

And again, "in shall judge His people."31It is fearsome to fall into the hands of the living Elohim.
