• Deut10:12 "And now, Yisra'ĕl, what is יהוה your Elohim asking of you, but to fear יהוה your Elohim, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, and to serve יהוה your Elohim with all your heart and with all your being,13to guard the commands of יהוה and His laws which I command you today for your good?14"See, the heavens and the heaven of heavens belong to יהוה your Elohim, also the earth with all that is in it.15 יהוה delighted only in your fathers, to love them.
