ABOUT US

DCC KIDS MISSION - To lead Kids and families into a growing relationship with Jesus.

DCC KIDS AGES - Infants - 5th grade

SERVICE TIMES - Sundays 9:30am and 11:15am (Doors open 15 minutes before service start times.)

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

CHECK-IN - All children are checked-in at the check-in desk. Each child will receive a name tag with a unique code. Parents/guardians will receive a claim ticket with a matching code.

PICK-UP - Leaders must match the Parent's claim ticket it to the child's tag number. For safety, children will not be released without a matching claim ticket.

CONTACT & COMMUNICATION

REGISTRATION - New Families will complete a family registration form. Current families are asked to update their form annually or as needed. This form asks for basic profile and contact information, as well as medical notes and diaper changing permissions (as needed).

IN-SERVICE CONTACT - If needed during service, Parents will be paged by displaying their child's claim ticket number on the screens used for the adult service.

VOLUNTEERS

SAFETY - All adult (aged 18+) volunteers are required to complete a criminal background check as well as adhere to safety policies and procedures set in place by DCC. Volunteers age 17 and younger may only serve as an assistant to an adult volunteer.



DCC KIDS PRESCHOOL ENVIRONMENTS

PRESCHOOL CLASS

Preschool class is for children age 3 years - Kindergarten. Children get an opportunity to experience age-appropriate worship, Bible lesson videos, and small group activities.

NURSERY CLASS

Nursery is for birth thru 2 years old. Children 24-36 months will be promoted to the Preschool class if parents and staff determine that is the most developmentally appropriate environment for the child. The Nursery classroom is also a comfortable space where nursing mothers are allowed to privately feed their baby.




