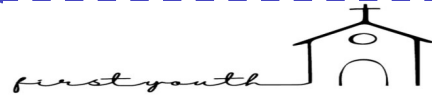

During the month of August, we are joining with other NC Baptist churches to pray for the Afghan, Dari, Turk and Persian people groups. These groups live in Central Asia. There are an estimated 2000 Afghan and Dari people, 5500 Persian people and 1500 Turks now calling our state home. Pray for them to know God's love and grace in Jesus Christ.
