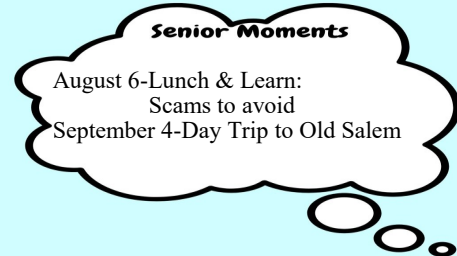

GriefShare Is Beginning in August!

Do you need help dealing with grief? Sometimes when we lose someone close to us, we do not feel like anyone can possibly know what we are experiencing. But you are not alone. There are other people who do know the same pain and loneliness that loss can bring. There are others who are willing to share their struggles and experiences with you to help in your time of need.
