### LET'S PRAY

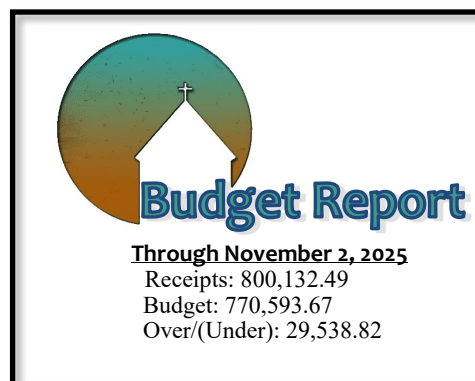
