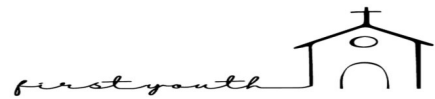

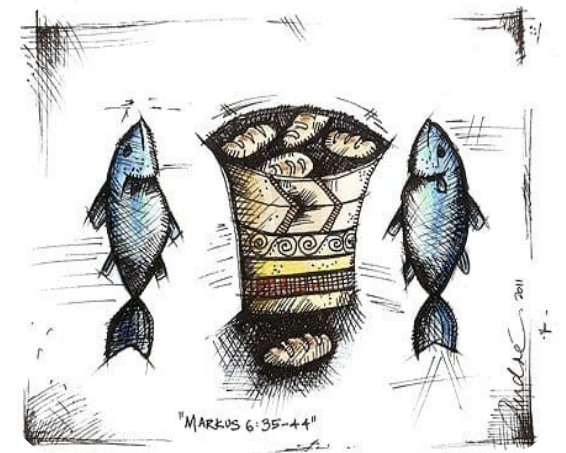
GriefShare
