Fri, Apr 12 | 9:00a-2:00p

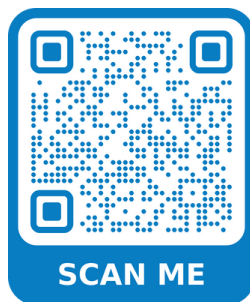
From time to time we will take field trips that will afford us additional opportunities to grow together.
