

## **TODAY FROM GOD'S WORD**




**Peter Escapes Prison** Acts 12:6-10

- Who is someone you can pray for?


Praying is just like talking to God, and we can talk to Him about things that make us happy or sad, people who need His help, and things that we are thankful for. No matter what, we can keep on praying!
