Small Group Discussion Questions

GOSPEL:

1. When has Scripture corrected an assumption or belief you once held? How did you respond?
2. What keeps us from receiving correction from God's Word as readily as Apollos did?
3. How can you discern whether your understanding of Scripture is shaped more by culture or by God's Word itself?

COMMUNITY:

1. What does Aquila and Priscilla's private conversation with Apollos teach us about the right posture for correcting someone who is gifted but incomplete in understanding?
2. What prevents mature believers from remaining teachable, and how can we guard against that?
3. Why do you think many believers avoid hard conversations, and what might be lost when we do?

MISSION:

1. When you talk about Jesus with others, do you tend to emphasize His benefits or His authority? Why?
2. How can you tell if you're sharing *your story* more than *God's story*?
3. What specific relationships or settings has God placed you in where His story could advance through you?
