Small Group Discussion Questions

GOSPEL:

- 1. When has Scripture corrected an assumption or belief you once held? How did you respond?
- 2. What keeps us from receiving correction from God's Word as readily as Apollos did?
- 3. How can you discern whether your understanding of Scripture is shaped more by culture or by God's Word itself?

COMMUNITY:

- 1. What does Aquila and Priscilla's private conversation with Apollos teach us about the right posture for correcting someone who is gifted but incomplete in understanding?
- 2. What prevents mature believers from remaining teachable, and how can we guard against that?
- 3. Why do you think many believers avoid hard conversations, and what might be lost when we do?

MISSION:

- 1. When you talk about Jesus with others, do you tend to emphasize His benefits or His authority? Why?
- 2. How can you tell if you're sharing *your story* more than *God's story*?
- 3. What specific relationships or settings has God placed you in where His story could advance through you?
