Experiment: "Clothing" the Dirty Water

Supplies:

- 2 clear cups or jars
- Dirty water (mix soil, food coloring, or pepper in water)
- Coffee filter, paper towel, or fabric (to represent "clothing")
- Rubber band
- Clean water

Steps:

- 1. Show the kids the dirty water. Explain this is like our hearts without God's love—full of selfishness and meanness.
- 2. Place the filter or fabric over the empty cup and secure it with a rubber band. This represents "putting on" compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.
- 3. Slowly pour the dirty water through the filter.
- 4. The filtered water will be much cleaner in the second cup. (It may not be perfect, but visibly better.)
- 5. Explain: Just like the filter keeps out dirt, when we clothe ourselves with love, it changes how we act. It helps keep out anger, unkindness, and selfishness.


"Just like the filter helped clean the dirty water, God changes our hearts when we believe in Jesus. On our own, our hearts are like the dirty water—full of sin. But when we trust in Jesus, He forgives us and gives us new life. That's the gospel—the good news! And as we grow as His followers, God keeps making us more like Jesus. The Bible calls this *sanctification*. Colossians 3:12–17 tells us to "put on" things like kindness, gentleness, patience, and love. That's like choosing every day to let God's Spirit work in us so our lives look more and more like Jesus."




