Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.
Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What do the scripture passages say? Read 1 John 3:1-10*

1. According to this passage, what are we called?
 2. What is the motivator behind God calling us his children?
 3. According to this passage, what are we to *not* practice?
 4. What are we to ‘practice’ as children of God?
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**Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*
*How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?***

5. What identity often takes precedence over ‘child of God’ in your own life?
 6. What is the life-changing significance of being called a child of God?
 7. How do we reconcile verse 6 with our continual struggle with sin in life?
 8. In that context (question above), how important is maintaining a heart of repentance?
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Surrender: *Responding to God’s voice.*

9. Is our group one where we feel safe and able to share about our sin struggles?
 - a. If not, is this something we should work towards?
10. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
