Getting Started

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What do the scripture passages say? Read 1 John 3:1-10

- 1. According to this passage, what are we called?
- 2. What is the motivator behind God calling us his children?
- 3. According to this passage, what are we to *not* practice?
- 4. What are we to 'practice' as children of God?

Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?

- 5. What identity often takes precedence over 'child of God' in your own life?
- 6. What is the life-changing significance of being called a child of God?
- 7. How do we reconcile verse 6 with our continual struggle with sin in life?
- 8. In that context (question above), how important is maintaining a heart of repentance?

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.

- 9. Is our group one where we feel safe and able to share about our sin struggles?
 - a. If not, is this something we should work towards?
- 10. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
